WA Productivity Places Program Media Release

The Productivity Places Program (PPP) Phase III is part of the Commonwealth Government's Skilling Australia for the Future initiative and aims to reduce skill shortages and increase the productivity of industry and enterprises.

The Western Australian Department of Education and Training advertised the 2009 PPP - Phase III and called for applications (CFA) from Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) to deliver training services to commence in the remainder of the 2009 calendar year.

The CFA will close at Midnight Thursday 2 July 2009. A second stage of the CFA will be open between 9 - 24 September 2009.

The 2009 PPP consisted of two parts:

1. Job Seeker Training Program

The objective of the 2009 Job Seeker Training Program is to fund training that will build foundation skills and pathways for people into employment.

2. Existing Worker Training Program

The objective of the 2009 Existing Worker Training Program is to fund training that will improve the skills of existing workers in industry areas that address identified skill shortages.
