# Construction, Plumbing and Services Industry Training Profile



- NSW RTOs delivering training in the Construction Industry
  - BCG03 - 73 private RTOs & 10 TAFE Institutes
  - BCF00 - 2 private RTOs & 10 TAFE NSW Institutes
  - BCP03 - 6 private RTOs & 10 TAFE NSW Institutes

# Recent TP Endorsement Process



- ISC “owns” the Training Package and responsible for reviews including consultation
- Consultation process with all stakeholders
- State Training Agencies teleconference
- NQC endorsement
- Minister approval
- Listing on NTIS
- Available for purchase through ISC and TVET

# New TP Endorsement Process



- Continuous improvement environment
- Stakeholders can provide feedback at any time
- Issues Register on ISC web site
- ISC will manage the process to minimise disruption

# NSW Process



- “accredited” at the subsequent VETAB Board meeting, in the case of CPC08, 23 February 2009
- VETAB sends email alert to RTOs telling them how to proceed to get the revised qualifications on scope
- Information about the transition process or training packages is posted on the VETAB website under Training Package Updates

# RTO Process



- RTOs have 12 months from the date of the VETAB accreditation to implement the new package
- Last enrolment date for the BCG03, BCP03 and BCF00 is 22 February 2010
- RTOs need to move students across to the revised qualifications as soon as practical so as not to disadvantage them

# Purpose of Workshops



- RTO understands requirements of the TP
- Future plans for continuous improvement of TP
- RTO representative takes the information back to the RTO staff and ensures appropriate implementation e.g. new L&A strategy, new assessments, new resources

# Workshops (continued)

- Workshop includes some PD if possible customised to meet industry needs
- Work with DET Industry Programs, the ISC and state ITAB (where applicable) – industry consultation – and licensing or regulatory authorities
- Opportunity to provide feedback on TP to Industry Skills Council and ITAB
- Opportunities for networking

# Adding the qualifications

## 4 options



1. Automatic replacement of superseded qualifications
2. Replacement of superseded qualifications following attendance at a workshop
3. Submit an amendment to scope application
4. Amendment to scope application PLUS attendance at a workshop

# How does VETAB decide?

- Risk factors
  - Different outcome?
  - Licensing requirements?
  - Other regulatory requirements?
  - Funding availability – state and national?
  - Industry issues with training?
  - Level of the qualification?
  - Volume of delivery?
  - Complaints?

# CPC08 Construction, Plumbing and Services



- RTOs can submit an amendment to scope application for CPC08 revised qualifications at any time
- Attendance at the CPS ISC workshop will facilitate the replacement of superseded BCG03, BCP03 and BCF00 qualifications that are mapped as having the “same essential outcome”

# Licensing Matters



- The CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry is designed to meet OH&S regulatory authority requirements for OH&S induction
- This is a compulsory unit in the CPC10108 Certificate I in Construction
- RTOs delivering this unit of competency in NSW require the approval of WorkCover NSW prior to delivering training and assessment services

# Licensing Matters (cont)



- There are 12 new high risk work licensing units in the CPC08 training package
- RTOs wishing to add these units to their scope need to submit an amendment to scope application
- Licensing units are included in CPC30508 Certificate III in Dogging, CPC30908 Certificate III in Scaffolding or CPC30708 Certificate III in Rigging
- In order to deliver training and assessment services for licensing purposes in NSW must also have written approval from WorkCover NSW

# CRICOS

- There is NO replacement process on the CRICOS register
- CRICOS providers need to put in a separate application for each qualification from each Training Package
